



QE PDP ground rules:

Confidentiality – What is said in the room stays in the room and is not shared with others. This does NOT include what teachers must report and pass on by law.

Use of “I” statements –students to talk about themselves and their own feelings, not those of others.

It’s okay to pass – you may choose not to participate in a specific activity, you have the option of passing by sitting quietly.

No judgments – People may have different levels of knowledge or ask questions that you didn’t expect. No laughing at others.

No personal questions or comments – Inform students that it is not appropriate to ask personal questions of the teacher or other students. If someone chooses to share something personal – their privacy is to be protected outside of the classroom (see confidentiality above).

Open minded – you may already have your own ideas and beliefs around this topic and some of the information shared may be different– an important part learning is to be open to hearing something new and challenging your own views and beliefs.

Self-Care- Students you need to take care of yourself in the sessions and can leave if it is too difficult.
